<u>Academic Achievement Program (AAP)</u> School Year 2016-2017

Academic Achievement Program (AAP) teachers will provide supplemental instruction in Language Arts Literacy and Mathematics for identified students in grades K-8.

Eligibility for AAP is determined by student performance on state and/or district assessments, classroom academic progress, and additional assessment measures. This program is designed to meet students' individual instructional needs.

The goal of the program is to remediate targeted skills and/or gaps in learning in order for our students to perform at a level equal with his or her grade placement.

Pull-out and push- in class instruction is offered in Language Arts and/or Mathematics for grades 1- 5 and for grades 6-8.

Each student academic progress is monitored each marking period. At the end of the school year a determination is made whether AAP should be offered for the following year.

Placement Criteria (Grades 1-8)

Mathematics and Language Arts

- i-Ready diagnostic assessment #3
- Final Math and/or Language Arts grade
- Beginning of the Year Assessments

**** Student must meet at least 2out of the 3 criteria in Math and/or Language Arts for placement in program

Other methods of possible placement in program:

• AAP Teacher Recommendation; Building Principal Recommendation Teachers are responsible for differentiated instruction on a daily basis.

Progress reports will be provided for parents/guardians each marking period.
